O'NEAL PLAZA TE GRANT RENOVATIONS

Transportation Enhancement (TE) Funds from the Georgia Department of Transportation are helping to make the renovation O'Neal Plaza possible. This new TE project will provide enhancements to O'Neal Plaza that will continue to offer a quality of life experience in Downtown Douglasville. The project will provide a more pleasant experience for citizens and visitors to the commercial business district, City Hall and O'Neal Plaza.

O'Neal Plaza was constructed in 2001 with partial funding provided by the Livable Centers Initiative (LCI). Through the years the Plaza has experienced great success and has welcomed thousands of visitors each year. The city holds annual festivals on the Plaza where visitors and residents enjoy the culture and historic nature of the downtown area. Although the improvements performed in 2001 were very beneficial, the years have revealed some deficiencies that need to be addressed.

NEW FOUNTAIN

This Downtown improvement projects main feature is the construction and new location of the plaza fountain.

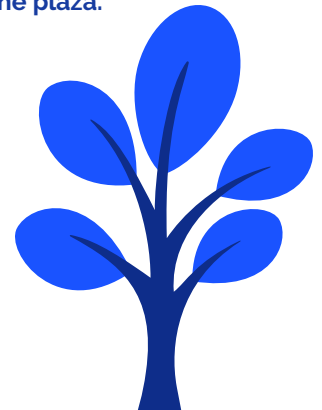
The new water feature will be interactive and more appealing to visitors of the Plaza and will provide a more aesthetically pleasant experience for the enjoyment of all.

The project has also been upgraded to be handicap accessible and meet the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards. The main thorough-fair of the plaza will be made one level with the ADA ramp provision on the northern end of the plaza.
